|     | Gather your materials.   |
|     | Lay the materials out on a flat work surface.  |
|     | Don't limit yourself to just one pattern per present.                                  |
|     | For large gifts, consider layering two or more papers of different colors or patterns. |
|     | Wrap a long piece of ribbon around the gift box lengthwise.                            |
|     | If you have a card, slide it under the ribbon and secure it with tape.                 |
|     | To make the actual present a surprise, wrap a toy or model-size version of it.         |
|     | Attach a note that gives clues to the location of the real thing.                      |
|     | Package small presents with a twist by wrapping them to look like candy canes.         |
