

Adoption Checklist

- Meeting Adoption Requirements
 - You must be over 19 years of age.
 - If married, marriage must be of at least 3 years duration.
 - You must have adequate housing & personal space for the child or children adopted.
 - You must be healthy enough to meet a child's needs.
 - You must be willing to undergo a thorough background check.
- Preparation for Child Adoption
 - Determine what type of adoption is right for you.
 - Attend programs specifically designed to educate potential adoptive and foster parent families.
 - Join local and internet adoptive parent support groups.
 - Check an adoption professional or agency out with the licensing authority in its home state.
 - Consider hiring or consulting an experienced and reputable adoption attorney.
 - Be cautious if you are offered a referral before you have a completed and approved homestudy.
 - Find a child available for adoption.
 - Get approved as an adoptive resource or obtain consent to adoption.
 - Obtain adoption petitions.
 - Meet the children in pre-placement visits.
 - Upon the signing of a placement agreement, child will be placed in your home.
- Parenting After Adoption
 - Exchange information with other adoptive parents.
 - Participate in the support groups.
