- Duties Before the Wedding
 - Offer services to the groom to help organize the wedding.
 - Arrange for the bachelors dinner and, or party.
 - Help pick out the tuxes.
 - Make sure the groom has all the accessories for his outfit.
 - Select a gift for the groom.
 - Act as a liaison for the groom's friends and family.
 - Confirm honeymoon travel arrangements.

 - Find out what the first dance is, and learn how to dance to that style.
 - Make sure the groom is at the church or wedding location at least 1/2 hour before the ceremony.
 - Make sure the groom has the marriage license in his pocket.
 - Ensure that the groom is ready to walk down the aisle.
- Duties on The Day of the Wedding
 - Wake up the groom in plenty of time to prepare for the wedding.
 - Look after the ring!
 - Organize the ushers.
 - Make sure the ushers are at the church at least an hour before the ceremony.
 - Organize everyone for the photos.
 - Go over the speech again.
 - Do your speech!
 - Read telegrams or special mail for the bride and groom.
 - Dance with the bride's mother and bridesmaids.
