	Arrage a show committee and divide the key jobs between a group.
	Find models for the show.
	Consider hiring a band or singer to perform at the show.
	Think about how you are going to introduce the show.
	Determine a theme for the show.
	Arrange clothing for the show - find designers and brands that fit your show theme.

	Show producer ensures that everyone else knows what they are doing and are doing it.
	Backstage manager ensures that everything goes exactly to plan on the day.
	Entertainment manager inform the other performers about rehearsal times and dates.
	Stylist/wardrobe manager is responsible for the content of the show.
	Hair and make-up artist creates image for the models.
	Casting manager makes certain that all models know what they are doing.
	Program nad guest list manager designs the show program and compiles as well as manage guest list.
	Promotional manager advertises the event.
