Pool Cleaning Checklist

Cleaning a Pool

- Clean deck around the pool or spa of all leaves and debris to keep them from blowing into the pool.
- □ Check water level.
- Check water chemistry Use a test kit or take a sample to the local pool store.
- □ Use a surface skimmer or leaf net to collect all floating debris.
- □ Clean the tile around the pool edge, using only pool tile soap.
- Be sure that all equipment is operating correctly and there are no visible leaks.
- □ Clean the skimmer basket and the pump strainer basket if needed.
- □ Check the pressure on the filter while the pump is running
- □ Vacuum the pool using the correct vac-head for your pool surface.
- □ Brush the entire pool using the nylon brush attached to the tele-pole.
- □ Brush the walls first and then brush the floor staring at the shallow end and working toward the bottom drain.
- Be sure to put all the pool cleaning equipment and chemicals away safely.
