| | | Take your tent out of its storage bag. |
| | | Spread it out on the ground and check for any tears or rips in the fabric |
| | | Run all of the zippers to make sure they are all working properly. |
| | | Make sure that you have all of your tent polls and stakes. |
| | | If you have fiberglass tent polls, make sure that the elastic bands that hold them together is in good shape. |
| | | If any of the bands are starting to fray, can pickup a repair kit. |
| | Sleeping Gear | |
| | | Roll out sleeping bags on the floor to make sure that they are in good shape. |
| | | Check if the sleeping bags need to be washed. |
| | | Check the zippers are working properly. |
| | | Have some extra blankets just incase. |
| | | If you use an air mattress fill it with air - find and fix any air leaks. |
| | Tarps | |
| | | Have two tarps for your tent - one to place under, one to place above the tent. |
| | | Spread the tarps out and make sure they are in good shape. |
| | | Have a few extra larger tarps to go over your picnic table. |
| | Camp Stove & Cooking Gear | |
| | | Try out your stove before leaving. |
| | | Have your stove repaired in case it's dried out. |
| | | Have separate pots, pans and utensils for camping. |
| | | Have a small plastic wash tub and some scrubbing pads. |
| | Personal Gear | |
| | | Make sure you have enough warm clothes. |
| | | Bring along extra pairs of clothes, shoes, coats and rain gear. |
| | | Take all items you use on a daily basis. |
| | | Make a list of what is in the hygiene kit and tape it to the inside of the lid to make it easier to see if you have everything. |
