- Car Preparation
 - Make sure your car is in good working order.
 - Be sure the battery is charged and is secured properly prior to shipping a car.
 - Clean your vehicle prior to shipping.
 - Have a low level of fuel prior to leaving your car with the auto transport company.
 - Disable your car alarms.
 - Remove all valuables and personal items from the car.
 - Lower the antenna or remove it.
 - Do not leave hazardous chemicals or flammable items in the car.
 - Make sure your car is prepped for any climate changes.
 - Check all fluids levels.
 - Make sure that you vehicle is personally insured.
 - Remove car phones and GPS systems
 - Anything that is removable from the exterior of your car should be taken off.
 - Take note of any chips, nicks, and scratches in the glass on your car.
 - Fold in your mirrors.
- Car Shipping Company
 - Review your car shipping quotes and call back the shipping companies.
 - Check the regulations of the vehicle mover.
 - Make sure the auto transport company has set of keys for your car.
 - Have the right paperwork ready.
 - Make sure you inspect your vehicle with the auto shipping company.
 - Let the auto transporter know if there is anything odd or different.
