- Language Development
  - Recognizes and identifies all upper and lowercase letters.
  - Writes simple sentences.
  - Speaks in complete sentences.
  - Asks meaningful questions.
  - Contributes appropriately to discussions.
  - Communicates needs clearly.
  - Able to tell story from pictures.
  - Retells important details in a story.
  - Recognizes rhyming words.
  - Matches spoken words to written words.
  - Writes independently using age appropriate spelling.
- Math Skills
  - Counts through and beyond 10.
  - Recognizes, writes, and uses whole numbers through 10.
  - Places numerals in proper sequence 1-10.
  - Identifies more/than and less/than.
  - Recognizes shapes.
  - Makes comparisons (size, length).
  - Understands concept of estimating.
  - Able to do simple addition.
- Fine and Gross Motor Skills
  - Holds pencil correctly.
  - Holds scissors correctly.
  - Cuts on line.
  - Forms shapes correctly.
  - Can trace a pattern.
  - Hops on one foot.
  - Skips and jumps.
